Entry terms and conditions for Brands Hatch

Entry to the circuit will be allowed from 5pm on Fri eve until 10 pm. If you arrive Sat morning it must be between 6.30 and 7.30 am latest as the paddock will be locked down at 8am. Entrance is via the Main entrance by the Thistle Hotel.

The main gate will have your registration number to gain entry with your truck. Your tickets will be issued when you book in with us at 10.00am on Sat morn. You will receive 2 x adult tickets per entry, with children under 12 being free. These tickets must be shown at the main gate if you go out Sat eve and return Sun am. Brands staff will not let anyone in after 10.00 am Sat without a ticket.

Dont forget NO animals are allowed at a race circuit.

When you are allowed to enter the main gate please proceed slowly with your hazards on to the waiting point to be parked (adjacent first toilet block) Parking places are allocated by myself only on a first come first served basis.

There can be no trying to save places for trucks coming later as this is neither fare on the trucks that do make it on time, and messes up the final display trying to squash them in gaps that are not big enough. You may however wait outside until your friends arrive and then be parked together.

It is a condition from Brands Hatch that the area allocated to us to park on is used for Show Trucks only. No cars or support vehicles can remain in this area after 8.00pm fri eve. They need to go in public car park (No Charge)

No tents / gazebo,s of any sort can be erected, or campers or caravans are allowed in the Show Truck area overnight or otherwise for the whole weekend. Every year this is a problem for me, but this is a Brands rule and although I assure them it will not happen, it still does! So if tents etc start appearing in the parking area this time it will result in future entries being declined.

Camping is allowed and free within the campsite, which is where your camper, caravan etc can be sited if you bring it. It is only approx 100 yards from the Show Truck area.

This weekend is a NO Airhorns at any time event, anyone found obusing this rule will be asked to leave the circuit. The track parade will take place at around 5pm on Sunday and it is expected you will take part please. You must sign on with us for this to obtain a wristband and whilst out on track please respect the circuit by staying on the tarmac and refraining from slowing down and speeding up and weaving around. We cannot afford to have an accident on track.

The prize giving will take place around 2pm on Sunday with the judging being carried out Sat pm and Sun am. Entertainment will be in the Kentagon Sat eve with food and drink available Fri and Sat eve.

Finally it is only after the truck parade that Show Trucks can leave the circuit due to the show being held in a pedestrianised area while racing is on track. In an EMERGENCY ring Steve Horne to marshall you out on 07831 373425

Upon booking in it will be assumed you have read and agree to abide by these rules of the weekend.
